Church Road is home to seven residents with learning disabilities.

The home is based in a quiet area of Frampton Cotterell, close to local shops.

The home consists of:

- Seven bedrooms
- Lounge
- Conservatory
- Dining room
- Two bathrooms
- Large garden

Church Road is adapted for wheelchair access and a house vehicle is available to take residents out.

Current residents of the home are all aged between 53 and 88.

Activities

Residents of Church Road take advantage of a good location, going out to local shops, church and community groups. Activities take place as and when the ladies and gents prefer.

Activities in the home include gardening. Residents and staff grow vegetables in the garden and enjoy planting seeds and watching them grow. Also, there are in house activities such as painting, arts and crafts and singalong afternoons.

Holidays are also taken each year to places such as Tenerife, Wales and Blackpool. Residents choose where they want to go and who they want to go with.

Staff encourage family links and residents regularly get visits from relatives or go out to visit their family.
