Furber Road is a spacious bungalow situated in St George.

The home provides 24-hour care and support for people with learning disabilities and caters for people with a range of complex needs including physical disabilities, communication difficulties, visual and auditory impairment.

Support is provided for everything residents require help with, including personal care, feeding, activities and going out.

The home accommodates give residents, currently aged 45-77.

Facilities

The home has spacious rooms, specially adapted to suit people using rolators and wheelchairs.

Facilities include:

- Five bedrooms, three with en-suite facilities
- Two additional bathrooms, adapted for service users
- Kitchen
- Dining room
- Lounge
- · Large garden

Communication

Most residents at Furber Road are non-verbal communicators and staff are skilled at communicated with each service user in their own unique way. Residents will often use gestures and signs to demonstrate what they would like and the well-established team at Furber Road know residents well enough to understand their needs.

Staff use photographs and pictures of food and activities to support residents to make their own choices.
