The home provides 24-hour support to seven residents with enduring mental health needs, providing a homely, safe and secure atmosphere in which residents can reach their full potential.

The home aim is to continually seek to be responsive to the changing needs and wishes of the residents.

Facilities

Each resident has their own bedroom at the home. There is also comfortable communal areas where residents can relax and socialise if they wish to. The home consists of:

- Lounge
- Three toilets/shower rooms, one on the ground floor
- Patio area
- Kitchen/living room
- Additional seating area
- Conservatory
- Large gardens

Experienced staff team

There's a long-standing staff team at Teewell who are experienced in providing personal, social and emotional support for people with mental health needs.

Staff can provide support for people with a variety of needs including cognitive behaviour impairment and challenging behaviour.

A person-centred home

Residents at Teewell Avenue are currently adults aged 18 and over. Residents enjoy spending time inside the home reading, watching television, doing crosswords and spending time in the home's large garden.
