#### What have they said they are going to do?

- 1.Invest in free personal care to ensure that all older people meet the needs for their personal care and to extend the provision to all working-age adults.
- 2. Develop eligibility criteria to tackle complex conditions
- 3. Spend no more than £100K on catastrophic care (an individual)
- 4. Invest in care packages (Double the number of people receiving care packages or reverse the damage of the spending cuts)
- 5. Higher standards for awarding organisations for providing care (quality care and ethical delivery, transparency, compliance, & profit capping)

#### What have they said they are going to do?

- 1.Development of a progressive health and care by other tax reductions, to set the spending on social care and health transparent.
- 2. Establish a cross-party on health and social care convention to reach agreement on the long-term sustainable funding.
- 3. Introduce a statutory independent budget monitoring body for health and care to report if the spending was efficient.
- 4. Increase spending on NHS by increasing income tax and invest in *equipment*, *hospitals*, *community*, *ambulance* and *mental health services buildings*
