Court View provides a home and support to four adults who have learning disabilities. Based in the village of Pucklechurch, people we support are encouraged to live a busy social life, in the village and beyond. Staff build their support around each individual and people we support are empowered to make their own decisions about their lives and the support they receive.

THREE GREAT THINGS ABOUT COURT VIEW

Wide-ranging support - Staff are experienced at supporting people with a range of different needs, including behaviours that challenge and downs syndrome.

Creative communication - For people we support who don't use verbal communication, pictures and prompts are used to enable them to make choices.

A spacious home - The home is spacious with bedrooms both on the ground floor and upstairs. Other facilities include a wetroom and a good sized garden.
