An Art Facilitator plans and leads art sessions. They help people express themselves through art.



The course will help people learn to lead art sessions. It is a chance to be creative and help others.



It is open to adults aged 18 and over with learning disabilities in South Gloucestershire.



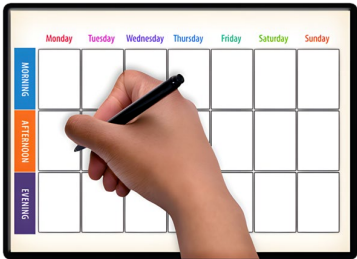
We have joined with a college to offer the course, so you will get an official qualification when you finish it.

	This helps people to get paid or unpaid employment without needing high levels of Maths or English.
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What do we need help with?	
	We are inviting up to 10 adults to help us create this course. You will get coaching and be credited for your work.
	As part of this group, you will:
	Build confidence in leading
	Develop ideas for supporting others in creative activities

	Explore how to help people with different needs
	Work together as a team
	Any creative adult with a learning disability in South Gloucestershire is welcome, even if you do not speak much or at all. We want people of all abilities.

When and where will the course take place?

	The course sessions will be held at Page Community Hall in Bristol.
